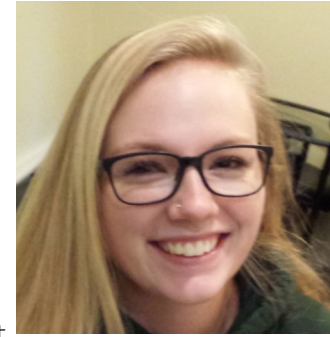

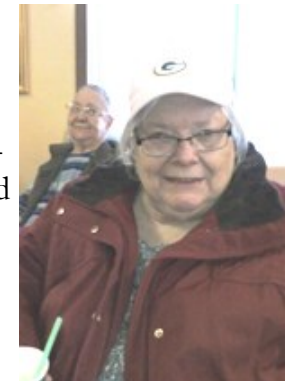
She has traveled to Sanibel Island in Florida and would like to travel to places like Bora Bora and Guatemala.
