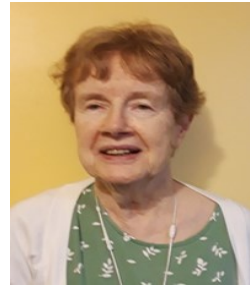

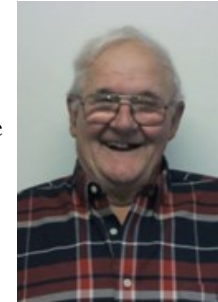

OVEN ROASTED SMOKED SAUSAGE & POTATOES

16 oz pkg smoked sausage, sliced; 1 lg onion, peeled & chopped; 5 lg potatoes, peeled & chopped into 1/2 cubes; 2 tbsp. olive oil; salt & pepper to taste; 2 tsp paprika; 1 tsp dried thyme; 1 c shredded cheddar cheese

Preheat oven to 400 degree F. Line a large baking tray with sides with foil and spray with cooking spray. Put the sausages, onions and potatoes into a large bowl. Drizzle with olive oil, and season with salt and pepper, paprika and dried thyme. Toss together and pour onto the baking tray. Place in oven and roast for 45 min to an hour, stirring half way through, until the potatoes are golden brown and tender. Scatter the cheese over the top and put back into the oven a few minutes to melt the cheese. Makes 4 servings.
