Soft Lemonade Cookies- Prep 10 min, Bake 10 min per batch, Yield: 6 dozen

1c butter, softened

1 c sugar

2 eggs

3 c flour

2 eggs

1 t baking soda

1 can 6oz frozen lemonade concentrate, thawed, divided

1. In large bowl, cream butter and sugar 'til light and fluffy. Add eggs one at a time, beating well. Combine flour and baking soda; add to the creamed mix alternately w/ 1/3 of thawed lemonade concentrate. Beat well after each addition.

2. Drop rounded tsp, 2 in. apart on ungreased sheets. Bake at 400 degrees, 8-10 min, remove to wire racks. Brush warm cookies w/ remaining lemonade concentrate; sprinkle w/ sugar. Cool.
